

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 5767**

A bill to amend 1976 PA 390, entitled
"Emergency management act,"
(MCL 30.401 to 30.421) by adding section 7b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 7b. (1) Beginning on the effective date of the amendatory
2 act that added this section, the emergency management division
3 established under section 7a shall stockpile medical supplies in
4 this state's emergency operations centers that are necessary to
5 respond to a state of disaster or a state of emergency within this
6 state.

7 (2) The division shall do all of the following:

8 (a) Coordinate all the medical supplies maintained and
9 stockpiled by all state departments in this state. The department



1 shall use its discretion in implementing the provisions of this
2 section and shall work with other state departments to maintain the
3 stockpiled medical supplies.

4 (b) Rotate the stockpiled medical supplies to avoid continued
5 stockpiling of expired medical supplies.

6 (c) Sell the rotated medical supplies prior to their
7 expiration date or donate the rotated medical supplies to an
8 educational program.

9 (3) The division shall display a list of the medical supplies
10 inventory, including quantities and expiration dates, on a website
11 that is fully accessible to the public at no cost. Notwithstanding
12 subsection (5), the division shall maintain the list required under
13 this subsection regardless of whether funds are appropriated under
14 this section.

15 (4) The list of the medical supplies inventory stockpiled
16 under subsection (1) is subject to disclosure under the freedom of
17 information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246.

18 (5) The legislature shall appropriate funds to implement this
19 section.

20 (6) As used in this section:

21 (a) "Division" means the emergency management division of the
22 department.

23 (b) "Medical personnel" means a health professional, hospital
24 staff, first responder, mortuary science professional, or an
25 individual that works in a medical laboratory or mortuary or
26 provides pathology, histology, necropsy, or autopsy services.

27 (c) "Medical supplies" means equipment or supplies necessary
28 for the proper and timely implementation of universal or standard
29 precautions by medical personnel in response to the specific



1 medical situation presented in that setting.

2 (d) "Stockpiled medical supplies" means the total medical
3 supplies stockpiled and maintained by all state departments in this
4 state and coordinated by the division under this section.
