SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6005

A bill to amend 1987 PA 96, entitled
"The mobile home commission act,"

(MCL 125.2301 to 125.2350) by adding section 16b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 16b. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, if the department denies a license application under section 16, the department shall give written notice of the denial by registered mail to the applicant stating reasons for the denial and the right to appeal the denial to the commission. An applicant denied a license may request an appeal before the commission on the denial not later than 15 business days after the United States Postal Service confirmed delivery of the denial. On receipt of the applicant's appeal, the commission shall hold a hearing on the



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- 1 appeal and issue a determination to the department. The commission
- 2 shall issue the determination within 120 days of the applicant's
- 3 appeal. If the commission makes a determination that is different
- 4 from the department's decision, the commission shall issue a
- 5 written opinion stating the reasons for the determination,
- 6 including the applicable statutory provision or promulgated rules
- 7 it relied upon in making that determination. On receipt of the
- 8 commission's determination, the department shall do either of the
- 9 following:
- 10 (a) Issue the license to the applicant if the determination
- 11 states that the department must issue the license.
- 12 (b) Decline to issue the license if the determination rejects
- 13 the applicant's appeal.
- 14 (2) If the commission fails to issue a determination under
- 15 subsection (1) within 120 days of the applicant's appeal, the
- 16 department shall consider the commission's failure to issue the
- 17 determination as a determination to issue the license, unless the
- 18 commission meeting was unable to be held due to an inability of a
- 19 majority of its members to attend and would have failed to have a
- 20 quorum.
- 21 (3) A licensed owner of a mobile home park or seasonal mobile
- 22 home park shall notify the department of any of the following
- 23 within 30 days of its occurrence:
- 24 (a) A change of ownership.
- 25 (b) A change of the mailing or electronic business address of
- 26 the licensed owner of the mobile home park or seasonal mobile home
- 27 park.
- 28 (4) An owner of a mobile home park or seasonal mobile home
- 29 park that sells a mobile home park or seasonal mobile home park



- 1 shall, within 30 days of the sale, provide the department with a
- 2 copy of the sales contract or any recorded deed and notify the
- 3 department of all of the following:
- 4 (a) The identity of the buyer of the mobile home park or
- 5 seasonal mobile home park, including the contact information of the
- 6 buyer.
- 7 (b) The date of the sale.
- 8 (c) Any change in the seller's contact information.
- 9 (5) The department in consultation with the commission shall
- 10 promulgate rules pursuant to the administrative procedures act of
- 11 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328, to do all of the
- 12 following:
- 13 (a) Provide standards and procedures for the commission to
- 14 determine whether a mobile home park or seasonal mobile home park
- 15 that is not in substantial compliance with the rules promulgated
- 16 under sections 5 and 6 is a distressed park. The standards and
- 17 procedures must provide the owner of the mobile home park or
- 18 seasonal mobile home park with an opportunity for an evidentiary
- 19 hearing and require the commission to consider, at least, all of
- 20 the following:
- (i) The length of time the mobile home park or seasonal mobile
- 22 home park has not been in substantial compliance with the rules
- 23 promulgated under sections 5 and 6.
- 24 (ii) Whether the owner of the mobile home park or seasonal
- 25 mobile home park was notified and had sufficient opportunity to
- 26 bring the mobile home park or seasonal mobile home park into
- 27 substantial compliance.
- 28 (iii) Any imminent threat to the health or safety of the
- 29 residents of the mobile home park or seasonal mobile home park.

- 1 (*iv*) Whether the mobile home park or seasonal mobile home park 2 has been or is likely to be abandoned by the owner.
- 3 (b) Require the owner of a distressed mobile home park or
 4 seasonal mobile home park to post financial assurance in the form
 5 of a bond, cash deposit, or other financial arrangement to ensure
 6 the repair and cleanup of the mobile home park or seasonal mobile
 7 home park, including the repair of substandard or noncomplying
 8 park-owned utility systems and the removal and disposal of
 9 abandoned mobile homes, scrap material, or other waste.
