SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6177

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 510 (MCL 168.510).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 510. (1) At least once a month, the county clerk shall
- 2 forward a list of the last known address and birth date of all
- 3 persons—individuals over 18 years of age who have died within—in
- 4 the county to the clerk of each city or township within in the
- 5 county. The city or township clerk shall compare this list with the
- 6 registration records and cancel the registration of all deceased
- 7 electors.
- 8 (2) For each registered elector who has been assigned a
- 9 placeholder date of birth on the qualified voter file because the





- 1 actual date of birth of the registered elector is unknown, the
- 2 secretary of state shall, by March 31, 2021, send by forwardable
- 3 mail both of the following to the elector:
- 4 (a) A postage prepaid and preaddressed return card on which 5 the elector may verify his or her date of birth.
- 6 (b) A notice that contains the following statement:
- 7 "Secretary of state records indicate that your date of birth
- 8 is not on the qualified voter file. To confirm your status as a
- 9 registered voter, please complete and return the enclosed card
- 10 providing your date of birth to the secretary of state at least 15
- 11 days before the next election. If you do not complete and return
- 12 the enclosed card to the secretary of state at least 15 days before
- 13 the next election, you will be required to affirm your date of
- 14 birth at the polls before you are permitted to vote. To keep your
- 15 status as a registered voter, you must respond to this notice,
- 16 vote, or engage in voting-related activity, including, but not
- 17 limited to, requesting an absent voter ballot application or
- 18 updating your voter registration, by the first business day after
- 19 the second general November election that is held after the date on
- 20 this notice."
- 21 (3) If a notice sent under subsection (2) is returned to the
- 22 secretary of state by the post office as undeliverable, the
- 23 secretary of state shall identify the registration record of that
- 24 elector as challenged as provided in this act. If the elector does
- 25 not vote or engage in voting-related activity by the first business
- 26 day after the second general November election that is held after
- 27 the date on the notice, the secretary of state shall cancel the
- 28 registration of that elector and notify the appropriate city or
- 29 township clerk of the cancellation.
