SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6315

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 2253 (MCL 333.2253), as amended by 2006 PA 157.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2253. (1) If Except as otherwise provided in subsections
- 2 (4) and (5), if the director determines that control of an epidemic
- 3 is necessary to protect the public health, the director by
- 4 emergency order may prohibit the gathering of people persons for
- 5 any purpose and may establish procedures in the emergency order to
- 6 be followed during the epidemic to insure ensure continuation of
- 7 essential public health services and enforcement of health laws.
- 8 Emergency procedures shall not be are not limited to this code.
- 9 (2) If an epidemic described in subsection (1) involves avian





- 1 influenza or another virus or disease that is or may be spread by
- 2 contact with animals, the department of agriculture and rural
- 3 development shall cooperate with and assist the director in the
- 4 director's response to the epidemic.
- 5 (3) Upon On request from the director, the department of
- 6 agriculture and rural development shall assist the department in
- 7 any review or update of the department's pandemic influenza plan
- 8 under section 5112.
- 9 (4) The director shall not prohibit in an emergency order
- 10 issued under this section the gathering of persons for a
- 11 professional or collegiate sporting event held at an entertainment
- 12 venue. However, the director may limit the occupancy of the
- 13 entertainment venue at which a professional or collegiate sporting
- 14 event is held to 20% capacity or a maximum of 12,500 spectators,
- 15 whichever is less. As used in this subsection:
- 16 (a) "Entertainment venue" means a facility that is primarily
- 17 used for sporting events or other entertainment.
- 18 (b) "Professional or collegiate sporting event" includes, but
- 19 is not limited to, any of the following:
- 20 (i) A game or match sanctioned by a major professional league
- 21 or the National Collegiate Athletic Association consisting of teams
- 22 located in the United States or Canada for any of the following
- 23 activities:
- 24 (A) Ice hockey.
- 25 (B) Football.
- 26 (C) Soccer.
- 27 (D) Baseball.
- 28 (E) Basketball.
- 29 (ii) A motorsports race and its ancillary activities that have

- 1 been sanctioned by a sanctioning body as that term is defined in
- 2 section 518 of the Michigan liquor control code of 1998, 1998 PA
- 3 58, MCL 436.1518.
- 4 (iii) A soccer match between 2 international soccer clubs as
- 5 part of a tournament sanctioned by the governing body for soccer in
- 6 the United States.
- 7 (5) In an emergency order issued under this section, the
- 8 director shall not prohibit the gathering of persons at a
- 9 convention facility. However, the director may limit the occupancy
- 10 at a convention facility to 20 persons per 1,000 square feet. As
- 11 used in this subsection, "convention facility" means that term as
- 12 defined in section 3 of the state convention facility development
- 13 act, 1985 PA 106, MCL 207.623.
