SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1180

A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act,"

(MCL 205.91 to 205.111) by adding section 4hh.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 4hh. (1) Beginning January 1, 2021, the tax under this act does not apply to the storage, use, or consumption of an instore consumer goods micro-fulfillment system or system parts by a retailer.
 - (2) As used in this section:
- 6 (a) "Consumer goods" means finished goods for use primarily
 7 for personal, family, or household purposes.
- 8 (b) "Fulfillment of online orders" means the processing of 9 orders from consumers that were made over the internet and the



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- 1 selection, assembly, storage, and staging of the consumer goods
 2 ordered.
- 3 (c) "In-store consumer goods micro-fulfillment system" means
 4 equipment, including, but not limited to, computers, computer
 5 software, storage systems, refrigerators, and freezers, that meets
 6 both of the following requirements:
- 7 (i) Is used by a retailer exclusively for the fulfillment of online orders of consumer goods for delivery to or pick up by the consumer.
- (ii) Is located in a building that is owned, leased, or used by a retailer and in which at least half of the building's square footage is used as an operating retail store.
- (d) "System parts" means machinery, equipment, repair parts, and computer software that are component parts of an in-store consumer goods micro-fulfillment system.
