A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending sections 565, 710, and 711 (MCL 168.565, 168.710, and 168.711), sections 565 and 711 as amended by 1984 PA 113.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 565. (1) Proof Not less than 58 days before the primary election, proof copies of the ballots shall must be placed on file in the office of the county clerk. at least 14 days prior to the primary election, and, at At the time of filing, the county clerk shall send by email 1 proof copy of the ballot shall be sent in counties with a population of 1,500,000 or more by registered or certified mail with return receipt demanded, and in counties with less than 1,500,000 by first class mail to the secretary of state

(1) At the time of filing the proof copy of the ballot at the office of the county clerk, the county board of election commissioners shall direct the county clerk to send in counties with a population of 1,500,000 or more by registered or certified mail, with a return receipt demanded, and in counties with less than 1,500,000 by first class first-class mail a proof copy of the official ballot to each candidate whose name appears on
- the ballot at to the candidate's last known address listed on his
 or her affidavit of identity. If a candidate provides an email
 address on his or her affidavit of identity, the county clerk may
 also send a proof copy of the ballot to the candidate by email.

- within 2 business days of the receipt of the ballot by telephone or 1 email with the corrections. noted on the ballot. The board of 2 election commissioners shall correct errors found in the ballot by 3 the inspection provided for in this section and at the expiration 4 of the 2-day correction period shall proceed with the printing of 5 6 the ballots. All corrections must be received by the county clerk 7 no later than 4 p.m. on the fifth business day after the proof copy 8 of the ballot is mailed to each candidate as provided in subsection 9 (1). After 4 p.m. on the fifth business day after the county clerk 10 mails the proof copy of the ballot to each candidate as provided in 11 subsection (1), the county clerk is authorized to begin printing 12 the ballots.
