## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 602

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 5111a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 5111a. (1) Notwithstanding section 5111 or 9227 or any other provision of this code, the department shall not promulgate or enforce a rule requiring a child to receive an EUA vaccination, wear a face mask, or be tested for COVID-19 if the child is asymptomatic for COVID-19, to do any of the following:
  - (a) Enter or attend a school in this state.
  - (b) Ride a school bus or other school-related vehicle.
- 8 (c) Participate in or attend a school-sponsored activity or 9 event, whether or not it is held on school premises. A school-

- 1 sponsored activity or event described in this subdivision includes,
- 2 but is not limited to, participation in or attendance at school-
- 3 sponsored sports, band, theater, educational trips, or other
- 4 extracurricular activities.

- (2) As used in this section:
- 6 (a) "COVID-19" means severe acute respiratory syndrome
  7 coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2).
- 8 (b) "EUA vaccination" means a vaccine authorized by the United 9 States Food and Drug Administration for emergency use.
- 10 (c) "Face mask" means a tightly woven cloth or other
  11 multilayer absorbent material that closely covers an individual's
  12 mouth and nose.
- 13 (d) "School" means a public school or a nonpublic school as 14 those terms are defined in section 5 of the revised school code, 15 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless Senate Bill No. 600 of the 101st Legislature is enacted into law.
