SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 627

A bill to provide for the recovery or replacement of durable monuments defining the Michigan-Indiana state line; to create a commission; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and agencies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "Michigan-Indiana state
 line monumentation act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Commission" means the Michigan-Indiana state line 5 commission established in section 5(1).
- 6 (b) "Monument" means a relatively permanent physical marker.
- 7 Sec. 5. (1) The Michigan-Indiana state line commission is



- 1 established.
- 2 (2) The commission consists of 10 members, 5 from the state of
- 3 Indiana and 5 from this state, who shall be known as state line
- 4 commissioners. The 5 members from the state of Indiana shall be
- 5 appointed under the laws of the state of Indiana. The 5 members
- 6 from this state are the elected county surveyors of Berrien County,
- 7 Cass County, St. Joseph County, Branch County, and Hillsdale County
- 8 and shall serve ex officio.
- **9** (3) The first meeting of the commission shall be called by the
- 10 director of the department of licensing and regulatory affairs. At
- 11 the first meeting of the commission, the commission shall elect
- 12 from among its members a chairperson and other officers as it
- 13 considers necessary or appropriate. After the first meeting, the
- 14 commission shall meet at least quarterly, or more frequently at the
- 15 call of the chairperson or if requested by 6 or more members.
- 16 (4) A majority of the members of the commission appointed from
- 17 this state and a majority of the members of the commission
- 18 appointed from the state of Indiana, together, constitute a quorum
- 19 for transacting business. A vote in favor by a majority of the
- 20 members serving is required for any action of the commission.
- 21 (5) The commission shall conduct its business in compliance
- 22 with the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 23 (6) A writing that is prepared, owned, used, possessed, or
- 24 retained by the commission in performing an official function is
- 25 subject to the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231
- **26** to 15.246.
- 27 (7) A member of the commission appointed from this state is
- 28 not entitled to compensation for service on the commission but may
- 29 be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in

- 1 serving.
- 2 Sec. 7. The commission shall do all of the following:
- 3 (a) Administer a survey and remonumentation of the Michigan-4 Indiana state line.
- 5 (b) Recover or reestablish monuments at the mileposts and
- 6 intermediate monument control points of the Michigan-Indiana state
- 7 line as established in the 1827 federal survey that defined that
- 8 line. The commission also shall recover or reestablish monuments at
- 9 the posts originally set at or near the shores of lakes and large
- 10 rivers of the Michigan-Indiana state line as established in the
- 11 1827 federal survey, or witness corners for set posts. The
- 12 commission shall review the survey upon completion of each
- 13 milepost.
- 14 (c) Compile appropriate records and documents verifying the
- 15 location of the mileposts, and process those records and documents
- 16 through the state survey and remonumentation commission created in
- 17 section 3 of the state survey and remonumentation act, 1990 PA 345,
- **18** MCL 54.263.
- 19 (d) Resolve any differences revealed by the survey between
- 20 record documents and recovered evidence regarding the location of
- 21 mileposts defining the Michigan-Indiana state line.
- 22 Sec. 9. (1) Upon completion of the survey and remonumentation,
- 23 the commission shall submit the survey to the legislature of this
- 24 state for approval by public act.
- 25 (2) If the legislature approves the survey, for each milepost
- 26 or the posts originally set at or near the shores of lakes or large
- 27 rivers determined under this act, the commission shall do both of
- 28 the following:
- 29 (a) File with the appropriate county register of deeds a land

- corner recordation certificate under the state corner recordation
 act, 1970 PA 74, MCL 54.201 to 54.210d, that provides appropriate
 references and Michigan state plane coordinates.
- 4 (b) File a copy of the certificate under subdivision (a) with
 5 the state survey and remonumentation commission created under
 6 section 3 of the state survey and remonumentation act, 1990 PA 345,
 7 MCL 54.263.
- 8 Sec. 11. The commission shall procure professional surveying 9 services through negotiated contracts. The commission shall award 10 contracts only to persons incorporated in this state or with a 11 principal place of business in this state.
- Sec. 13. This act is repealed effective January 1, 2026.
