PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

**GENERAL SECTIONS**

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under part 1 for fiscal year 2022-2023 is \$27,074,600.00 and state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government for fiscal year 2022-2023 is \$14,984,900.00. The itemized statement below identifies appropriations from which spending to local units of government will occur:

**FAMILY HEALTH SERVICES**

Sec. 1301. (1) Before April 1 of the current fiscal year, the department shall submit a report to the house and senate fiscal agencies and the state budget director on planned allocations from the amounts appropriated in part 1 for local MCH services, prenatal care outreach and service delivery support, family planning local agreements, and pregnancy prevention programs. Using applicable federal definitions, the report shall include information on all of the following:

(a) Funding allocations.

(b) Actual number of women, children, and adolescents served and amounts expended for each group for the previous fiscal year.

(c) A breakdown of the expenditure of these funds between urban and rural communities.

(2) The department shall ensure that the distribution of funds through the programs described in subsection (1) takes into account the needs of rural communities.

(3) As used in this section, "rural" means a county, city, village, or township with a population of 30,000 or less, including those entities if located within a metropolitan statistical area.

Sec. 1303. The department shall not contract with an organization that provides elective abortions, abortion counseling, or abortion referrals, for services that are to be funded with state restricted or state general fund/general purpose funds appropriated in part 1 for family planning local agreements. An organization under contract with the department shall not subcontract with an organization that provides elective abortions,



1 abortion counseling, or abortion referrals, for services that are  
2 to be funded with state restricted or state general fund/general  
3 purpose funds appropriated in part 1 for family planning local  
4 agreements.

5 Sec. 1304. The department shall not use state restricted funds  
6 or state general funds, or allow grantees or subcontractors to use  
7 those funds, appropriated in part 1 in the pregnancy prevention  
8 program or family planning local agreements appropriation line  
9 items for abortion counseling, referrals, or services.

10 Sec. 1305. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for  
11 family planning local agreements and the pregnancy prevention  
12 program, the department shall not contract with or award grants to  
13 an entity that engages in 1 or more of the activities described in  
14 section 1(1) of 2002 PA 360, MCL 333.1091, if the entity is located  
15 in a county or health district where family planning or pregnancy  
16 prevention services are provided by the county, the health  
17 district, or a qualified entity that does not engage in any of the  
18 activities described in section 1(1) of 2002 PA 360, MCL 333.1091.

19 (2) The department shall give priority to counties or health  
20 districts where no contracts or grants currently exist for family  
21 planning or pregnancy prevention services before contracting with  
22 or awarding grants to an entity that engages in 1 or more of the  
23 activities described in section 1(1) of 2002 PA 360, MCL 333.1091,  
24 if that entity is located in a county where family planning and  
25 pregnancy prevention services are provided by the county, the  
26 health district, or another qualified entity that does not engage  
27 in the activities described in section 1(1) of 2002 PA 360, MCL  
28 333.1091.

29 Sec. 1347. The department shall not use state restricted funds



1 or state general funds appropriated in part 1, or allow grantees or  
2 subcontractors to use those funds, for abortion counseling,  
3 referrals, or services, or for any activities regarding human  
4 cloning or research in which a human embryo or embryos are  
5 destroyed or discarded.
