

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 1113**

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled
"Occupational code,"
by amending section 1201 (MCL 339.1201), as amended by 2020 PA 20.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1201. As used in this article:

2 (a) "Apprentice" means an individual who is engaged in
3 learning cosmetology in a cosmetology establishment.

4 (b) "Braiding" means providing or offering to the general
5 public for compensation any of the following services solely for
6 development or improvement of physical qualities of the natural
7 hair structure:

8 (i) Intertwining in a systematic motion to create patterns in a
9 3-dimensional form.



1 (ii) Inversion or outversion flat against the scalp along the
2 part of a straight or curved row.

3 (iii) Twisting in a systematic motion.

4 (iv) Extension with natural or synthetic fibers.

5 (c) "Cosmetologist" means an individual who performs or offers
6 to perform 1 or more cosmetology services.

7 (d) "Cosmetology" means performing 1 or more cosmetology
8 services.

9 (e) "Cosmetology establishment" means a place of business at
10 which 1 or more cosmetology services are offered or provided.
11 Cosmetology establishment includes a mobile salon and a cosmetology
12 suite. Cosmetology establishment does not include a school of
13 cosmetology.

14 (f) "Cosmetology services" means any of the following:

15 (i) Hair care services.

16 (ii) Skin care services.

17 (iii) Manicuring services.

18 (iv) Electrology.

19 (g) "Cosmetology suite" means a room or suite located inside a
20 licensed cosmetology establishment that is leased or rented from
21 the owner of the cosmetology establishment for the purposes of
22 offering or providing 1 or more cosmetology services.

23 (h) "Electrologist" means an individual who performs or offers
24 to perform electrology.

25 (i) "Electrology" means the permanent removal of hair from the
26 body of an individual by the use of electricity.

27 (j) "Esthetician" means an individual who performs or offers
28 to perform skin care services.

29 (k) "Hair care services" means arranging, cutting, dressing,



1 curling, waving, cleansing, singeing, bleaching, coloring, tinting,
2 trimming, styling, relaxing, perming, straightening, or similar
3 work upon the hair of the head or a wig that an individual is
4 wearing.

5 (l) "Instructor" means an individual who teaches or offers to
6 teach 1 or more cosmetology services in a school of cosmetology.

7 (m) "Manicuring services" means the cleansing, filing,
8 shaping, buffing, polishing, or beautifying of the nails of the
9 hands or feet, and the cleansing, massaging, stimulating,
10 exercising, or beautifying of the skin of the hands, arms, and
11 feet, manually or with the use of tools, appliances, or cosmetic
12 preparations, including the repair of nails, or the creation or
13 decoration of artificial nails. Manicuring services do not include
14 the practice of podiatric medicine and podiatric surgery as defined
15 in section 18001 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
16 333.18001.

17 (n) "Manicurist" means an individual who performs or offers to
18 perform manicuring services.

19 (o) "Mobile salon" means either of the following:

20 (i) A self-contained vehicle or other device that is moved,
21 towed, or transported from 1 location to another and in which
22 equipment used to perform 1 or more cosmetology services is
23 installed.

24 (ii) A business in which equipment used to perform 1 or more
25 cosmetology services is transported to and used on a temporary
26 basis at a location other than the premises of the owner,
27 including, but not limited to, any of the following:

28 (A) A cosmetology establishment owned by another person.

29 (B) A client's home.



1 (p) "Natural hair cultivation" means techniques that result in
2 tension on hair strands such as twisting, wrapping, weaving,
3 extending, locking, or braiding of the hair by hand. ~~, if that work~~
4 **Natural hair cultivation includes shampoo services. Natural hair**
5 **cultivation** does not include the application of dyes, reactive
6 chemicals, or other preparations to alter the color or to
7 straighten, curl, or alter the structure of the hair. **As used in**
8 **this subsection, "shampoo services" means preparing a customer for**
9 **a shampoo, or shampooing or blow-drying a customer.**

10 (q) "Natural hair culturist" means an individual who is
11 engaged in natural hair cultivation but does not include an
12 individual who is engaged in natural hair cultivation if that
13 activity is performed as part of the practice of a recognized
14 religion.

15 (r) "Owner" means a person who owns and conducts a cosmetology
16 establishment or a school of cosmetology.

17 (s) For a mobile salon, "premises" means 1 of the following,
18 as applicable:

19 (i) For a mobile salon described in subdivision (o) (i), the
20 vehicle or other device and the equipment installed in the vehicle
21 or device.

22 (ii) For a mobile salon described in subdivision (o) (ii), the
23 equipment used to perform the cosmetology services, and the
24 temporary location at which the equipment is used, while the
25 equipment is at that location.

26 (t) "School of cosmetology" means a school that teaches 1 or
27 more cosmetology services at a premises designated in the license
28 application.

29 (u) "Skin care services" includes the following services or



1 combination of services:

2 (i) Beautifying the skin of the body of an individual by the
3 use of cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics, lotions, or
4 creams, including body wrapping.

5 (ii) Cleansing or stimulating the skin of the body by the use
6 of the hands, devices, apparatus, or appliances, with or without
7 the use of cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics, lotions, or
8 creams.

9 (iii) The temporary removal of hair from the body of an
10 individual by the use of depilatories, waxes, razors, scissors,
11 clippers, or tweezers.

12 (iv) Giving facials, applying removable makeup, applying
13 eyelashes, or any other application of a preparation or beauty
14 enhancement to the body of an individual but does not include
15 applying permanent makeup or the use of tanning equipment.

16 (v) "Student" means an individual who is engaged in learning
17 cosmetology or 1 or more cosmetology services in a school of
18 cosmetology.
