SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4918

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 81g.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 81g. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person who assaults, or assaults and batters, an individual while the individual is performing the individual's duties as the operator of a bus, street railway vehicle, or train is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 93 days, a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
 - (2) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person who assaults an individual without a weapon and inflicts serious or aggravated injury on that individual without intending to commit

- 1 murder or to inflict great bodily harm less than murder while the
- 2 individual is performing the individual's duties as the operator of
- 3 a bus, street railway vehicle, or train is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 4 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year, a fine of not
- 5 more than \$2,000.00, or both.
- 6 (3) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person who
- 7 assaults an individual with a gun, revolver, pistol, knife, iron
- 8 bar, club, brass knuckles, or other dangerous weapon without
- 9 intending to commit murder or to inflict great bodily harm less
- 10 than murder while the individual is performing the individual's
- 11 duties as the operator of a bus, street railway vehicle, or train
- 12 is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than
- 13 4 years, a fine of not more than \$4,000.00, or both.
- 14 (4) A person who violates subsection (1) and has a prior
- 15 conviction under this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable
- 16 by imprisonment for not more than 180 days, a fine of not more than
- 17 \$2,000.00, or both.
- 18 (5) A person who violates subsection (2) and has a prior
- 19 conviction under this section is guilty of a felony punishable by
- 20 imprisonment for not more than 2 years, a fine of not more than
- 21 \$4,000.00, or both.
- 22 (6) A person who violates subsection (3) and has a prior
- 23 conviction under this section is guilty of a felony punishable by
- 24 imprisonment for not more than 8 years, a fine of not more than
- 25 \$8,000.00, or both.
- 26 (7) This section does not prohibit a person from being charged
- 27 with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation of law

- 1 (8) The owner of a bus, street railway vehicle, or train shall
- 2 post a sign in a prominent and visible location in each bus, street

- 11 the railroad code of 1993, 1993 PA 354, MCL 462.109.
- 12 (c) "Street railway service" means 1 or both of the following:
- 13 (i) A street railway as that term is defined in section 109 of
- 14 the railroad code of 1993, 1993 PA 354, MCL 462.109.
- 15 (ii) A street railway system as that term is defined in section
- 16 507 of the recodified tax increment financing act, 2018 PA 57, MCL
- 17 125.4507.
- (d) "Street railway vehicle" means a streetcar, trolly, or
- 19 tram that is operated on a rail.
- (e) "Train" means railroad train as that term is defined in
- 21 section 49 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.49.
- 22 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 23 after the date it is enacted into law.
