SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5304

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 634 (MCL 257.634), as amended by 2021 PA 43.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 634. (1) Upon On each roadway of sufficient width, the driver of a vehicle shall drive the vehicle upon on the right half of the roadway, except as follows:
- (a) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under the rules governing that movement.
- (b) When the right half of a roadway is closed to traffic while under construction or repair or when an obstruction exists making it necessary to drive to the left of the center of the highway. A driver who is driving on the left half of a roadway

under this subdivision shall yield the right-of-way to an oncoming
vehicle traveling in the proper direction upon on the unobstructed
portion of the roadway.

- (c) When a vehicle operated by a state agency or a local authority or an agent of a state agency or local authority is engaged in work on the roadway.
- (d) Upon On a roadway divided into 3 marked lanes for traffic under the rules applicable on the roadway.
- (2) Upon On a roadway having 2 or more lanes for travel in 1 direction, the driver of a vehicle shall drive the vehicle in the extreme right-hand lane available for travel except as otherwise provided in this section. However, the driver of a vehicle may drive the vehicle in any lane lawfully available to traffic moving in the same direction of travel when the lanes are occupied by a streetcar or vehicles moving in substantially continuous lanes of traffic and in any left-hand lane lawfully available to traffic moving in the same direction of travel for a reasonable distance before making a left turn or to avoid blocking, delaying, or otherwise interfering with the movement of a streetcar on a streetcar track.
- (3) This—Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, this section must not be construed to prohibit a vehicle traveling in the appropriate direction from traveling in any lane of a freeway having 3 or more lanes for travel in the same direction. However, a city, village, township, or county may not enact an ordinance that regulates the same subject matter as any provision of this subsection. The However, the driver of a truck with a gross weight of more than 10,000 pounds, a truck tractor, or a combination of a vehicle and trailer or semitrailer shall not drive the vehicle or

- combination of vehicles only in either of the 2 lanes in the lane
 farthest to the right, left on a freeway with 3 or more lanes for
 travel in the same direction except for a reasonable distance when
 making a left turn, or where a special hazard exists that requires
 the use of an alternative lane for safety reasons, or if otherwise
- 6 posted because of a closure to traffic for construction or repair.
- 7 (4) If a freeway closes 1 or more lanes due to construction 8 resulting in only 2 usable lanes on the freeway, the driver of a 9 truck with a gross weight of more than 10,000 pounds, a truck 10 tractor, or a combination of a vehicle and trailer or semitrailer 11 shall drive in the rightmost lane except for a reasonable distance when making a left turn, where a special hazard exists that 12 13 requires the use of an alternative lane for safety reasons, or if 14 otherwise posted for construction or repair.
- 15 (5) A city, village, township, or county may not enact an 16 ordinance that regulates the same subject matter as any provision 17 of subsection (3) or (4).
- 18 (6) (4) A person An individual who violates this section is 19 responsible for a civil infraction.
