SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5584

A bill to amend 1978 PA 472, entitled

"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate lobbyists, lobbyist agents, and lobbying activities; to require registration of lobbyists and lobbyist agents; to require the filing of reports; to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of state; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 4.414), as amended by 2008 PA 289.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) "Gift" means a payment, advance, forbearance, or
- 2 the rendering or deposit of money, services, or anything of value,
- 3 the value of which exceeds \$25.00, as adjusted under section 19a,
- 4 in any 1-month period, unless consideration of equal or greater
- 5 value is received therefor. for the payment, advance, forbearance,
- 6 or the rendering or deposit of money, services, or anything of





- 1 value. Gift includes a payment, advance, forbearance, or the
- 2 rendering or deposit of money, services, or anything of value to
- 3 aid the defense of an official in the legislative branch or an
- 4 official in the executive branch against a legal action not
- 5 directly related to the governmental duties of the official. Gift
- 6 does not include any of the following:
- 7 (a) A campaign contribution otherwise reported as required by
- 8 the Michigan campaign finance act, 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 to
- 9 169.282.
- 10 (b) A loan made in the normal course of business by an
- 11 institution as that term is defined in chapter 1 section 1202 of
- 12 the banking code of 1999, 1999 PA 276, MCL 487.11101 to 487.11203,
- 13 MCL 487.11202, a national bank, a branch bank, an insurance company
- 14 issuing a loan or receiving a mortgage in the normal course of
- 15 business, a premium finance company, a mortgage company, a small
- 16 loan company, a state or federal credit union, a savings and loan
- 17 association chartered by this state or the federal government, or a
- 18 licensee as that term is defined by in section 2 of the motor
- 19 vehicle sales finance act, 1950 (Ex Sess) PA 27, MCL 492.101 to
- 20 492.141.MCL 492.102.
- 21 (c) A gift received from a member of the person's individual's
- 22 immediate family, a relative of a spouse, a relative within the
- 23 seventh degree of consanguinity as computed by the civil law
- 24 method, or from the spouse of the relative.
- 25 (d) A breakfast, luncheon, dinner, or other refreshment
- 26 consisting of food and beverage provided for immediate consumption.
- (e) A contribution to a legal defense fund that is registered
- 28 with the secretary of state under the legal defense fund act, 2008
- 29 PA 288, MCL 15.521 to 15.539, and $\frac{\text{whose}}{\text{the purpose}}$ of which is to

- 1 defend an elected **public** official against any criminal, civil, or
- 2 administrative action, that arises directly out of the conduct of
- 3 the elected **public** official's governmental duties.
- 4 (f) Anything of value that is so de minimis that its receipt
- 5 by the elected public official could not reasonably be expected to
- 6 influence how the public official performs work or makes decisions.
- 7 Anything of value provided to an elected public official under this
- 8 subdivision must have a total fair market value that does not
- 9 exceed a de minimis value regardless of whether its cost is split
- 10 among more than 1 individual. Anything of value that is so de
- 11 minimis as described under this subdivision may not exceed any of
- 12 the following limits:
- 13 (i) A single tangible or intangible item with a fair market
- 14 value that exceeds \$20.00.
- 15 (ii) A combination of tangible and intangible items during any
- 16 3-month period with an aggregate fair market value exceeding
- 17 \$80.00.
- 18 (g) Cost for attendance at a conference, a training session,
- 19 or another meeting if attendance is primarily for the benefit of
- 20 this state and the expenses incurred by the elected public official
- 21 would be reimbursable items under applicable travel regulations or
- 22 other policies.
- 23 (2) "Immediate family" means a child residing in an
- 24 individual's household, a spouse of an individual, or an individual
- 25 claimed by that individual or that individual's spouse as a
- 26 dependent for federal income tax purposes.
- 27 (3) "Loan" means a transfer of money, property, or anything of
- 28 ascertainable value in exchange for an obligation, conditional or
- 29 not, to repay in whole or in part.
