SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5585

A bill to amend 2023 PA 281, entitled "Public officers financial disclosure act," by amending sections 3 and 7 (MCL 15.703 and 15.707).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Blind trust" means a qualified blind trust or qualified3 diversified trust as those terms are defined in 5 CFR 2634.403.
 - (b) "Department" means the department of state.
- 5 (c) "Earned income" means salaries, wages, tips, bonuses,
 6 commissions, or other compensation or earnings from employment
 7 earned during the reporting period.
- 8 (d) "Form" means the financial disclosure form created by the9 department in accordance with section 11.



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- (e) "Gift" means that term as defined in section 7 of the
 Michigan campaign finance act, 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.207.
- 3 (f) "Honorarium" means that term as defined in section 7 of4 the Michigan campaign finance act, 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.207.
- 5 (g) "Immediate family" means a parent, child, sibling, or 6 spouse of a public officer or a relative of any degree residing in 7 the same household as that public officer.
- 8 (h) (g) "Liabilities" means what a person owes to another
 9 person, including, but not limited to, mortgages or other debts.
- 10 For purposes of this act, a debt does not include a revolving debt,
- 11 an unsecured debt that is from a financial institution or the
- 12 federal government, or a debt owed by a business entity.
- 13 (i) $\frac{\text{(h)}}{\text{"Lobbyist"}}$ means that term as defined in section 5 of 1978 PA 472, MCL 4.415.
- 15 (j) (i) "Lobbyist agent" means that term as defined in section 16 5 of 1978 PA 472, MCL 4.415.
- 19 (l) (k)—"Public officer" means all of the following:
- 20 (i) A state representative.
- 21 (ii) A state senator.
- 22 (iii) The attorney general.
- (iv) The governor.
- **24** (v) The lieutenant governor.
- 25 (vi) The secretary of state.
- 26 (m) (l) "Report" means the financial disclosure report required 27 under section 10 of article IV of the state constitution of 1963.
- 28 (n) (m)—"Reporting period" means the preceding calendar year.
- 29 (o) (n) "Unearned income" means income that is not earned from

- 1 employment, including, but not limited to, financial prize,
- 2 unemployment benefits, annuities, stock dividends, deferred
- 3 compensation, pension, profit sharing, or retirement income.
- 4 Unearned income does not include inheritance money or a familial
- 5 gift.
- 6 Sec. 7. (1) A report required under section 5 must include a
- 7 complete statement of all of the following:
- 8 (a) The full name, mailing address, telephone number, and
- 9 email address of the public officer.
- 10 (b) The name and address of the public officer's employer and
- 11 the positions held during the reporting period, if the public
- 12 officer receives \$1,000.00 or more in annual income from each
- 13 position.
- 14 (c) The name of the spouse of the public officer, the
- 15 occupation of the public officer's spouse, and the name of the
- 16 employer or employers of the public officer's spouse.
- 17 (d) Whether the public officer's spouse or immediate family
- 18 member was registered as a lobbyist or lobbyist agent under 1978 PA
- **19** 472, MCL 4.411 to 4.431, during the reporting period.
- (e) A list of all positions currently held as an officer,
- 21 director, trustee, partner, proprietor, representative, employee,
- 22 or consultant of any organization, corporation, firm, partnership,
- 23 or other business enterprise, nonprofit organization, labor
- 24 organization, or educational or other institution other than this
- 25 state. If this subdivision applies, the public officer shall
- 26 include the name of the organization. For purposes of this
- 27 subdivision, positions held in any religious, social, fraternal, or
- 28 political entity, or positions that are solely of an honorary
- 29 nature, are excluded.

- 1 (f) The source of earned income received during the reporting 2 period by the public officer. For purposes of this subdivision, the 3 public officer must shall report each source of income received 4 during the reporting period that is \$1,000.00 or more.
 - (g) Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision, a list of each asset, excluding a business asset, held for investment or production of income with a fair market value of \$1,000.00 or more during the reporting period and any sources of unearned income that exceed \$200.00 during the reporting period. The fair market value for the purpose of listing each asset, excluding a business asset, held for investment or production of income under this subdivision must be adjusted for inflation every 4 years using the Detroit Consumer Price Index, and rounded up to the nearest \$1,000.00.
- (h) A list of all liabilities that exceed \$10,000.00 owed bythe public officer to a creditor at any time during the reportingperiod.
 - (i) Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision, a list of any stocks, bonds, or other forms of securities held by the public officer or held jointly with the public officer's spouse or immediate family member during the reporting period, if the security has a total aggregate fair market value of \$1,000.00 or more. The fair market value for the purpose of listing stocks, bonds, or other forms of securities under this subdivision must be adjusted for inflation every 4 years using the Detroit Consumer Price Index, and rounded up to the nearest \$1,000.00. For purposes of this act, a public officer is not required to disclose a stock in a widely held investment fund, including, but not limited to, a mutual fund, regulated investment company, pension or deferred compensation plan, or other investment fund, if both of the

- 1 following apply:
- $\mathbf{2}$ (i) Either the fund is publicly traded or the assets of the $\mathbf{3}$ fund are widely diversified.
- 4 (ii) The public officer or the public officer's spouse or
 5 immediate family member does not exercise control over or have the
 6 ability to exercise control over the financial interests held by
 7 the fund.
- 9 holds an ownership or other financial interest. For purposes of this subdivision, the public officer is required to include a real property in the report only if that real property has a fair market value of \$1,000.00 or more during the reporting period. A public officer filing a report may exclude the street number of a parcel of real property under this subdivision.
- (k) The date of, identity of parties to, and general terms of 15 16 any agreements or arrangements with respect to future employment, a 17 leave of absence while serving as a public officer, continuation or 18 deferral of payments by a former or current employer other than 19 this state, or continuing participation in an employee welfare or 20 benefit plan maintained by a former employer. As provided in 21 section 8, there is an ongoing duty to report any agreement or 22 arrangement entered into by a public officer after the filing deadline described in section 5(2). 23
- 24 (l) A list of all gifts received and reported by a lobbyist or lobbyist agent under state law.
- (m) A list of all travel payments received and reported by alobbyist or lobbyist agent under state law.
- 28 (n) A list of all travel payments received from a person that 29 is not a lobbyist, a lobbyist agent, a spouse, a parent-in-law,



- sibling-in-law, or child-in-law that does not reside in the same household as that public officer, or an immediate family member.
- 3 (o) A list of all tickets for concerts, sporting events, or
 4 other entertainment received and reported by a lobbyist or lobbyist
 5 agent under state law.
- 6 (p) A list of all tickets for concerts, sporting events, or
 7 other entertainment received from a person that is not a lobbyist,
 8 a lobbyist agent, a spouse, a parent-in-law, sibling-in-law, or
 9 child-in-law that does not reside in the same household as that
 10 public officer, or an immediate family member.
- (q) (n)—A list of each payment made by a lobbyist or lobbyist
 agent to a charity in lieu of honoraria.
- (r) (o)—If applicable, a statement indicating that the public 13 14 officer or the public officer's spouse or immediate family member 15 is a registered vendor with this state, has a majority interest in 16 a company that is a registered vendor with this state, or is 17 employed by a company that is a registered vendor with this state. 18 If the public officer or the public officer's spouse or immediate 19 family member is a registered vendor with this state or has a 20 majority interest in a company that is a registered vendor with this state, the public officer shall include the name of the 21 company and a description of all contracts entered into with this 22 23 state by the public officer, public officer's spouse or immediate 24 family member, or company in which the public officer or public 25 officer's spouse or immediate family member has a majority interest during the reporting period. If the public officer or public 26 27 officer's spouse or immediate family member is employed by a company that is a registered vendor with this state, the public 28 29 officer shall include the name of the company and a description of

1 all contracts entered into with this state that the public officer
2 or the public officer's spouse or immediate family member directly
3 worked on directly during the reporting period.

- (s) A list and description of all conferences, training sessions, or other meetings attended by a public officer where the cost of attendance was paid by a lobbyist or lobbyist agent.
- (2) A public officer is not required to disclose the value of any real property or property disclosed under subsection (1).
- (3) If a public officer required to file a report under this section 5 holds a beneficial interest in a blind trust, the public officer is not required to include the interests or assets of the blind trust in the report. However, the public officer must shall indicate in the public officer's report that the public officer holds a beneficial interest in a blind trust. For purposes of As used in this subsection, beneficial "beneficial interest" includes, but is not limited to, the interest in a trust of a qualified trust beneficiary or trust beneficiary as those terms are defined under section 7103 of the estates and protected individuals code, 1998 PA 386, MCL 700.7103.
 - (4) A report required under section 5 must include the following certification: "I certify that the statements I have made on this financial disclosure form are true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief, and that I have not moved assets during the reporting period for the purpose of avoiding disclosure under the public officers financial disclosure act".

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless House Bill No. 5584 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into law.
