SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 519 as introduced 11-8-88:

The bill would amend Public Act 70 of 1977 to require the State Treasury to reimburse a local school district for taxes lost due to the establishment of Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore Park, by paying the district \$50,000 in 1988 and each year thereafter.

Under the Act, the State Treasurer was required to reinburse local units of government, for 10 years beginning in 1977, for taxes lost due to the establishment of Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore Park, Isle Royale National Park, the Sylvania tract in the Ottawa National Forest Park, and the Sene, National Wildlife Refuge Park. Payments to local units were based on the State equalized valuation of the lands for each taxing jurisdiction from which property was transferred, and the rate of taxation. Payments were reduced by 10% each year. The last payment was made in December 1986.

FISCAL IMPACT

The bill would result in a cost to the State of \$50,000 General Func/General Purpose n FY 1988-89 by providing an annual payment of \$50,000 to the Burt Township School District in Grand Marais (Alger County).

State equalized valuation (SEV) was reduced in two local school districts as a result of the establishment of Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore Park: Munising Public Schools in Munising and Burt Township Schools in Grand Marais. However, since Munising is an "in-formula" district, its SEV loss is fully restored through the general membership formula of the School Aid Act. Burt Township is out-of-formula and receives no such membership aid. Total payments in lieu of taxes to the two school districts under Public Act 70 of 1977 for the establishment of Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore Park over the 10-year period of 1977 through 1986 have been:
