## Senate Bill 718

Sponsor: Senator Jack Welborn

Committee: Criminal Justice, Urban Affairs, and Economic Development

SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 718 as introduced 2-18-88:

Senate Bill 718 would amend the Correctional Officers' Training Act to specify that any person beginning employment as a correctional officer in a maximum or medium security facility after the bill's effective date would have to meet "the same qualifications as to moral character, health, physical ability, and criminal record" as are required to become a State Police officer. These requirements would apply in addition to the other applicable requirements for a correctional officer. The State Police qualifications are spelled out in rules promulgated by the Law Enforcement Officers Training Council (R 28.4102 et seq.).
