SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 794 as introduced 4-12-88:

The bill would authorize the Department of Natural Resources to convey to the Lenawee County drain commissioner, for \$1, two parcels in the Waterford subdivision of the Lake Loch Erin Project. The conveyance would have to require that the land be used exclusively for public drainage related purposes. The conveyance would have to be by quitclaim deed approved by the Attorney General, and provide that the State would retain all mineral rights.
