SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 935 as introduced 6-23-88:

The bill would amend the Michigan Election Law to permit a clerk to assist in the delivery of a ballot container to the counting center or other designated place if sufficient election inspectors were not present or if the clerk determined that assistance in delivery was necessary. (Under the law's electronic voting system provisions, election inspectors are required to place unused ballots, voted ballots, and a report on the number of electors who voted, in a ballot container and deliver it to a counting center.)
