SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 952 as introduced 7-1-88:

The bill would amend the Solid Waste Management Act to specify that the Act would have to be "construed and administered to encourage and facilitate source separation and site separation of material from solid waste". The bill also would require the encouragement and facilitation of "other environmentally sound measures" in order to prevent materials from entering the waste stream.

The bill would have an indeterminate fiscal impact on the State, depending on whether "encourage and facilitate" included creation or expansion of new Department of Natural Resources programs.
