SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 1000 as introduced 9-22-88:

The bill would amend the Hazardous Waste Management Act to require the Director of the Department of Natural Resources to promulgate emergency rules relating to medical waste, pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act. The rules would have to include, but would not be limited to, rules relating to the treatment, storage, disposal, and tracking of medical waste.

The bill is tie-barred to Senate Bill 999, which would define "medical waste" and include untreated medical waste in the definition of "hazardous waste".
