SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 1008 as introduced 9-22-88:

The bill would amend the Public Health Code to require the Department of Public Health to promulgate rules to regulate the handling and disposal of infectious waste in private practice offices of veterinarians and in veterinary clinics. These rules would be in addition to rules proposed for promulgation under provisions of Senate Bill 1005, which deals with the handling, containment, decontamination, transportation, and disposal of infectious waste.

The bill is tie-barred to Senate Bill 1005.
