AN ACT to amend Act No. 181 of the Public Acts of 1963, entitled as amended "An act to promote safety upon the public highways by regulating the operation of motor trucks, tractors, and trailers; to provide the number of persons necessary to the operation of such motor trucks and tractors; to limit the hours of service of persons engaged in operating such vehicles; to require the keeping of records of such operations: to provide for the assessment of fees; to provide penalties for the violation of this act; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," as amended, being sections 480.11 to 480.21 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 7a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

- Section 1. Act No. 181 of the Public Acts of 1963, as amended, being sections 480.11 to 480.21 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 7a to read as follows:
- Sec. 7a. (1) By December 31, 1989, the truck safety commission shall make recommendations to the legislature with respect to an accident report form regarding accidents involving commercial motor vehicles.
- (2) As used in this section, "commercial motor vehicle" means that term as defined in section 7a of the Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, being section 257.7a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
