## ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 14

AN ACT to repeal sections 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 of Act No. 519 of the Public Acts of 1980, entitled "An act to authorize the governor to declare a prison overcrowding state of emergency under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of the governor and the commission of corrections; and to provide remedies for a prison overcrowding state of emergency," being sections 800.71, 800.73, 800.75, 800.77, and 800.79 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, on a specific date.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Sections 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 of Act No. 519 of the Public Acts of 1980, being sections 800.71, 800.73, 800.75, 800.77, and 800.79 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are repealed effective January 1, 1988.

Section 2. This act shall not take effect unless House Bill No. 4006 of the 84th Legislature is enacted into law.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
