

HOUSE BILL No. 4093

February 11, 1987, Introduced by Reps. Munsell, Martin, Bankes, Sparks, Connors, Fitzgerald, Oxender, Dunaskiss, Van Regenmorter, Allen, Browne, Ciaramitaro, DeBeaussaert, Farhat, Middaugh, Strand, Willis Bullard, Krause, Emmons and Hart and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 24 of chapter VII of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended
"The code of criminal procedure,"
being section 767.24 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 24 of chapter VII of Act No. 175 of the
2 Public Acts of 1927, being section 767.24 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

4 CHAPTER VII

5 Sec. 24. An indictment for the crime of murder may be found
6 at any ~~period~~ TIME after the death of the person alleged to
7 have been murdered. ~~indictments~~ INDICTMENTS for the crimes
8 of kidnapping, extortion, CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT AND ASSAULT
9 WITH INTENT TO COMMIT CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT IF THE VICTIM IS
10 LESS THAN 16 YEARS OF AGE, assault with intent to commit murder,

1 and conspiracy to commit murder shall be found and filed within
2 10 years after the commission of the offense. ~~; all~~ ALL other
3 indictments shall be found and filed within 6 years after the
4 commission of the offense. ~~; but any~~ ANY period during which
5 the party charged was not ~~usually and publicly~~ A resident
6 within this state shall not be ~~reckoned~~ CONSIDERED as part of
7 the time within which the ~~respective indictments~~ INDICTMENT
8 shall be found and filed.
