

HOUSE BILL No. 4244

March 5, 1987, Introduced by Reps. Hayes, Perry Bullard, Bartnik, Law, Hoffman, Connors, Gilmer, Emmons, Krause, Dunaskiss, DeMars, Middaugh, Munsell, Oxender, Power and Gagliardi and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend Act No. 17 of the Public Acts of 1963, entitled as amended

"An act to relieve certain persons from civil liability when rendering emergency care or when participating in a mass immunization program approved by the department of public health,"

as amended, being sections 691.1501 to 691.1505 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 7.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 17 of the Public Acts of 1963, as
2 amended, being sections 691.1501 to 691.1505 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 7 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 7. A PERSON WHO IS A REGISTERED MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL
6 SKI PATROL SYSTEM AND IN GOOD FAITH RENDERS EMERGENCY CARE AT THE
7 SCENE OF AN EMERGENCY SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR CIVIL DAMAGES AS A
8 RESULT OF ACTS OR OMISSIONS BY THE PERSON IN RENDERING THE

1 EMERGENCY CARE, EXCEPT ACTS OR OMISSIONS AMOUNTING TO GROSS
2 NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL AND WANTON MISCONDUCT.
