A bill to amend section 6 of Act No. 320 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended

"An act authorizing counties, cities, villages, and townships, either individually or jointly by agreement, to provide a sanitary means of disposing of the solid waste, refuse, garbage, sewage, night soil, and storm water thereof; to supply water thereto; to charge owners or occupants of premises therefor; to borrow money and issue bonds to own, acquire, construct, equip, operate, and maintain waterworks systems, intercepting sewers, other sanitary and storm sewers, sewage disposal plants, transfer stations, and garbage or refuse processing or disposal plants; and to provide for the levying of taxes without limitation as to rate or amount for the repayment of such bonds,"

being section 123.246 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 6 of Act No. 320 of the Public Acts of

- 4 Sec. 6. The governmental agencies or municipalities may

- 1 corporation -organized under or authorized by the laws of this
- 2 state to engage in the business herein mentioned, to receive,
- 3 treat, transfer, and process in the manner -hereinbefore
- 4 mentioned PROVIDED IN THIS ACT, the sewage, night soil, garbage,
- 5 and refuse -thereof- OF THE GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR MUNICIPALITY.
- 6 The contract may authorize the INDIVIDUAL, PARTNERSHIP, OR corpo-
- 7 ration to charge the owners of the premises served a service rate
- 8 determined by the public service commission GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY
- 9 OR MUNICIPALITY to be just and reasonable, or the governmental
- 10 agencies or municipalities may contract to pay -the corporation-
- 11 a flat rate for the service, paid out of their general fund, or
- 12 assess the owners of the property served a reasonable charge
- 13 -therefor to be collected as -hereinbefore provided IN THIS ACT
- 14 and paid into a fund to be used to defray the contract charges.
