## **HOUSE BILL No. 4661**

May 21, 1987, Introduced by Reps. Alley, Bartnik, Hickner, Gagliardi, Allen and Pridnia and referred to the Committee on Tourism and Recreation.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 42 of the Public Acts of 1905, entitled

"An act to define the duties and liabilities of hotel keepers and innkeepers with relation to the personal property of their guests, and to provide for the protection of inn and hotel keepers, and to repeal Act No. 227 of the Public Acts of 1897, and Act No. 15 of the Public Acts of 1875,"

being section 427.101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 42 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1905, being section 427.101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1. (1) The liability of the keeper of any inn, whether
- 5 individual, partnership, or corporation, for loss of or injury to
- 6 personal property of his THE INNKEEPER'S guest, shall be that
- 7 of a depository for hire, -- Provided, however, That EXCEPT
- 8 THAT in no case shall such liability exceed the sum of  $\frac{-250}{100}$
