THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The English language is adopted as the official
- 2 language of this state.
- 3 Sec. 2. Except as provided in section 3, a law, ordinance,
- 4 rule, regulation, order, decree, program, or policy of this state
- 5 or political subdivision of this state shall not require the use
- 6 of a language other than English.
- 7 Sec. 3. A law, ordinance, rule, regulation, order, decree,
- 8 program, or policy of this state or political subdivision of this
- 9 state may require educational instruction in a language other
- 10 than English for the purpose of making students who use a
- 11 language other than English proficient in English.
