## **HOUSE BILL No. 4768**

June 9, 1987, Introduced by Reps. Alley, Gagliardi, Pridnia, Ouwinga, DeMars, Jacobetti, Sitz, Weeks, Bartnik, Hart, Niederstadt, Sofio and Connors and referred to the Committee on Tourism and Recreation.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 74 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled as amended

"An act to register and regulate snowmobiles; to provide for education and training programs; to provide for trails, areas, and facilities; to create a recreational snowmobile trail improvement fund; to provide for expenditure of appropriations; and to prescribe penalties,"

as amended by Act No. 334 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 257.1504 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 10a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 74 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1968, as amended by Act No. 334 of the Public Acts of 1984, being
- 3 section 257.1504 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended and
- 4 section 10a is added to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 4. (1) The owner of each snowmobile requiring

- 1 OWNERSHIP file an application for registration with the
- 2 department on forms provided by the department. The application
- 3 shall be signed by the owner of the snowmobile and shall be
- 4 accompanied by a fee of \$15.00 30.00. Upon receipt of the
- 5 application in approved form, the department shall enter the
- 6 application upon its records and issue to the applicant a certif-
- 7 icate of registration. The certificate of registration shall
- 8 contain the number awarded to the snowmobile, the name and
- 9 address of the owner, and other information the department con-
- 10 siders necessary. The certificate of registration shall be
- 11 pocket size, shall accompany the vehicle, shall be legible, and
- 12 shall be made available for inspection upon demand by a peace
- 13 officer.
- 14 (2) The owner of a snowmobile at the time application for a
- 15 certificate of registration is made shall pay a fee of \$15.00
- 16 \$30.00 and be issued a certificate of registration and a regis-
- 17 tration decal. The certificate of registration and registration

- (4) THE DEPARTMENT MAY SUSPEND A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION
- 2 WHEN THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT THE REQUIRED FEE HAS NOT BEEN
- 3 PAID AND REMAINS UNPAID AFTER REASONABLE NOTICE OR DEMAND. IN
- 4 ADDITION TO THE REQUIRED FEE, A \$5.00 PENALTY SHALL BE ASSESSED
- 5 AND COLLECTED AGAINST ANY PERSON WHO TENDERS AN INSUFFICIENT
- 6 CHECK OR DRAFT IN PAYMENT OF THE FEE.
- SEC. 10A. A SNOWMOBILE REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE OR COUN-
- 8 TRY BY A NONRESIDENT OF THIS STATE MAY BE OPERATED IN THIS STATE
- 9 FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LONGER THAN 20 CONSECUTIVE DAYS. AFTER THE
- 10 20-DAY PERIOD, THE OWNER OF THE SNOWMOBILE SHALL REGISTER IT IN
- 11 THIS STATE.
