A bill to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978,

entitled as amended

"Public health code,"

as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 11101.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
2 amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 11101 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 11101. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DONATES OR SELLS HIS OR
6 HER BLOOD OR BLOOD PRODUCTS TO A BLOOD BANK OR STORAGE FACILITY
7 OR TO AN AGENCY OR ORGANIZATION THAT COLLECTS BLOOD OR BLOOD
8 PRODUCTS FOR A BLOOD BANK OR STORAGE FACILITY, KNOWING THAT HE OR
9 SHE HAS, OR HAS BEEN DIAGNOSED AS HAVING, AIDS OR ARC OR HAS

1 TESTED POSITIVE FOR THE PRESENCE IN HIS OR HER BODY OF HIV OR THE
2 ANTIBODY TO HIV, IS GUILTY OF A FELONY.

3 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

4 (A) "AIDS" MEANS ACQUIRED IMMUNODEFICIENCY SYNDROME.

5 (B) "ARC" MEANS AIDS-RELATED COMPLEX.

6 (C) "HIV" MEANS HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS.
