

# HOUSE BILL No. 5008

October 1, 1987, Introduced by Reps. Barns, Emerson and Pridnia and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend section 20161 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended

"Public health code,"

as amended by Act No. 376 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 333.20161 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 20161 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1978, as amended by Act No. 376 of the Public Acts of 1984,  
3 being section 333.20161 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended  
4 to read as follows:

5       Sec. 20161. (1) Fees for health facility and agency  
6 licenses and certificates of need shall be assessed on an annual  
7 basis by the department as provided in this act, in accordance  
8 with the following fee schedule:

1 (a) Freestanding surgical  
2 outpatient facilities..... \$ 238.00 per facility.

3 (b) Hospitals..... \$ 8.28 per licensed bed.

4 (c) Nursing homes, county medi-  
5 cal care facilities, and hospital  
6 long-term care units..... \$ 2.20 per licensed bed.

7 (d) Homes for the aged..... \$ 6.27 per licensed bed.

8 (e) Health maintenance  
9 organizations..... \$1,000.00 for an initial  
10 license; 80 cents per sub-  
11 scriber for a renewal license  
12 (3-year); \$100.00 for a certif-  
13 icate of authority for  
14 planning.

15 (f) Clinical laboratories..... \$ 475.00 per laboratory.

16 (G) HEALTH CARE DELIVERY AND  
17 FINANCING SYSTEM UNDER SECTION  
18 21042..... \$1,000.00 FOR AN INITIAL  
19 LICENSE; EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1,  
20 1987, \$1,000.00 FOR 3-YEAR

1 RENEWAL LICENSE FOR PREPAID  
2 INSTITUTIONAL PROGRAMS; AND  
3 \$5,000.00 FOR 3-YEAR RENEWAL  
4 LICENSE FOR ORGANIZATIONS  
5 DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO  
6 OFFER A SINGLE FORM OF HEALTH  
7 CARE SERVICE; 80 CENTS PER SUB-  
8 SCRIBER FOR ALL OTHER LICENSES  
9 UNDER SECTION 21042.

10 (2) The fee for a certificate of need shall be \$691.00 for  
11 each application for a project requiring a projected capital  
12 expenditure of \$150,000.00 or less and \$1,621.00 for a project  
13 requiring a projected capital expenditure of more than  
14 \$150,000.00.

15 (3) With the exception of health maintenance organizations,  
16 when licensure is for more than 1 year, the fees described in  
17 subsection (1) shall be multiplied by the number of years for  
18 which the license is issued, and the total amount of the fees  
19 shall be collected in the year in which the license is issued.

20 (4) Fees described in this section shall be payable to the  
21 department at the time an application for a license, permit, or  
22 certificate is submitted. If an application for a license,  
23 permit, or certificate is denied or if a license, permit, or cer-  
24 tificate is revoked before its expiration date, the fees paid to  
25 the department shall not be refunded.

1       (5) The fee for a provisional license or temporary permit  
2 shall be the same as for a license. A license may be issued at  
3 the expiration date of a temporary permit without an additional  
4 fee for the balance of the period for which the fee was paid if  
5 the requirements for licensure are met.

6       (6) The department may charge a fee to recover the cost of  
7 purchase or production and distribution of proficiency evaluation  
8 samples which are supplied to clinical laboratories pursuant to  
9 section 20521(3).

10       (7) In addition to the fees imposed under subsection (1), a  
11 fee of \$25.00 shall be submitted to the department for each reis-  
12 suance during the licensure period of a clinical laboratory  
13 license.

14       (8) Except for the licensure of clinical laboratories, not  
15 more than half the annual cost of licensure activities as deter-  
16 mined by the department shall be provided by license fees.

17       (9) Effective with the fiscal year beginning October 1,  
18 1982, the fees collected under this section shall be deposited in  
19 the state treasury, to the credit of the general fund.

20       (10) The fees imposed under subsection (1)(f) and  
21 subsection (7) pertaining to clinical laboratory licensure shall  
22 ~~expire on~~ NOT APPLY AFTER December 31, 1988.
