THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
- 2 amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 21541 to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 SEC. 21541. (1) THE GOVERNING BODY OF A HOSPITAL WHICH
- 6 INTENDS TO CLOSE SHALL DO BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) PASS A RESOLUTION WHICH SETS FORTH THE HOSPITAL'S INTENT
- 8 TO CLOSE.

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- 1 (B) NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT, ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE HOSPITAL,
- 2 AND ALL LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT WITHIN THE HOSPITAL'S SERVICE
- 3 AREA OF THE PASSAGE OF THE RESOLUTION DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION
- 4 (A) NOT LESS THAN 90 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE UPON WHICH THE HOSPITAL
- 5 INTENDS TO CLOSE.
- 6 (C) ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT TO INSPECT THE HOSPITAL'S FINANCIAL 7 RECORDS.
- 8 (2) NOT LATER THAN 45 DAYS AFTER THE DATE NOTICE IS GIVEN
- 9 UNDER SUBSECTION (1)(B), THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE HOSPITAL SHALL
- 10 PREPARE A HOSPITAL CLOSURE PREPARATION STATEMENT. THE HOSPITAL
- 11 CLOSURE PREPARATION STATEMENT SHALL INCLUDE BOTH THE FOLLOWING:
- 12 (A) A STATEMENT OF THE REASONS FOR THE CLOSURE OF THE 13 HOSPITAL.
- 14 (B) A STATEMENT REGARDING THE IMPACT OF THE CLOSURE OF THE
- 15 HOSPITAL INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 16 (i) THE TYPES OF SERVICES TO BE DISCONTINUED.
- 17 (ii) THE IMPACT ON THE AVAILABILITY OF THOSE SERVICES IN THE
- 18 HOSPITAL'S SERVICE AREA AND ANY ARRANGEMENTS WITH OTHER HEALTH
- 19 FACILITIES AND AGENCIES TO ASSURE THE CONTINUATION OF THE DISCON-
- 20 TINUED SERVICES IN THE SERVICE AREA OF THE HOSPITAL.
- 21 (iii) THE IMPACT ON OTHER HEALTH FACILITIES AND AGENCIES
- 22 LOCATED IN THE HOSPITAL'S SERVICE AREA.
- 23 (iv) ARRANGEMENTS THAT HAVE BEEN MADE WITH OTHER HEALTH
- 24 FACILITIES AND AGENCIES TO RECEIVE PATIENTS OR RESIDENTS WHO MUST
- 25 BE TRANSFERRED BECAUSE OF THE CLOSURE OF THE HOSPITAL.
- 26 (ν) THE IMPACT ON THE HOSPITAL PRIVILEGES OF PHYSICIANS
- 27 PRACTICING IN THE HOSPITAL'S SERVICE AREA.

- 1 (3) THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE HOSPITAL WHICH INTENDS TO
- 2 CLOSE, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, SHALL
- 3 DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A JOB RETRAINING PROGRAM AND JOB PLACEMENT
- 4 SERVICES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE HOSPITAL UTILIZING STATE AND FED-
- 5 ERAL JOB RETRAINING PROGRAMS AND JOB PLACEMENT SERVICES IN EXIS-
- 6 TENCE AT THE TIME THE HOSPITAL INTENDS TO CLOSE.
