

HOUSE BILL No. 5366

February 10, 1988, Introduced by Reps. Power, Fitzgerald, Hollister, Jondahl, Krause, Honigman, Strand, Mathieu, Allen, Hoekman and Ciaramitaro and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 9 of Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled as amended

"McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely lottery act,"

as amended by Act No. 62 of the Public Acts of 1987, being section 432.9 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of
2 1972, as amended by Act No. 62 of the Public Acts of 1987, being
3 section 432.9 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 9. The commissioner shall initiate, establish, and
6 operate a state lottery at the earliest feasible and practicable
7 time. The lottery shall produce the maximum amount of net
8 revenues for the state consonant with the general welfare of the
9 people. The commissioner shall solicit bids from financially

1 responsible vendors of data processing equipment and services for
2 the operation of the lottery and may contract with the approval
3 of the state administrative board. A CONTRACT UNDER THIS SECTION
4 SHALL BE AWARDED TO THE BIDDER WHO SUBMITS THE LOWEST BID, UNLESS
5 THE BIDDER SUBMITTING THE LOWEST BID CANNOT MEET, OR WILL NOT
6 AGREE TO MEET, THE SPECIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED IN THE BID PROPOSAL.
