

HOUSE BILL No. 5368

February 11, 1988, Introduced by Reps. Keith and O'Neill and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled

"The state school aid act of 1979,"

as amended, being sections 388.1601 to 388.1772 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 99.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, as
2 amended, being sections 388.1601 to 388.1772 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 99 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 99. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11,
6 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,000,000.00 FOR
7 1988-89 TO APPLICANT DISTRICTS AND INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS FOR THE
8 DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF VARIOUS PROFESSIONAL
9 DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS FOR TEACHERS. EACH DISTRICT AND

1 INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE \$70.00 PER TEACHER.
2 THE PROGRAMS MAY BE DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED UNDER THIS SECTION
3 BY A DISTRICT, AN INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT, A CONSORTIUM OF DIS-
4 TRICTS, A CONSORTIUM OF INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS, OR A CONSORTIUM
5 OF 1 OR MORE DISTRICTS AND 1 OR MORE INTERMEDIATE DISTRICTS.

6 (2) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION, A DIS-
7 TRICT OR INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT NOT
8 LATER THAN NOVEMBER 1, 1988 AN APPLICATION DEVELOPED BY THE
9 DEPARTMENT. THE APPLICATION SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED
10 TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

11 (A) THE NAMES AND ACADEMIC POSITIONS OF MEMBERS OF A
12 LONG-RANGE PLANNING COMMITTEE COMPRISED OF NOT LESS THAN 5 NOR
13 MORE THAN 10 CLASSROOM TEACHERS AND ADMINISTRATORS FROM THE DIS-
14 TRICT, INTERMEDIATE DISTRICT, OR CONSORTIUM, AS APPROPRIATE. THE
15 MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE TEACHERS.

16 (B) IDENTIFICATION OF THE GOALS OF THE LONG-RANGE PLANNING
17 COMMITTEE DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (A). THESE GOALS SHALL
18 INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, DEVELOPMENT OF 1 OR MORE ASSESS-
19 MENT STRATEGIES TO IDENTIFY, ON A CONTINUING BASIS, MAJOR TEACHER
20 NEEDS AND DEVELOPMENT OF A 3-TO 5-YEAR TEACHER IMPROVEMENT PLAN
21 TO MEET THOSE NEEDS FOR EACH SCHOOL WITHIN THE DISTRICT, INTERME-
22 DIATE DISTRICT, OR CONSORTIUM, AS APPROPRIATE.

23 (C) IDENTIFICATION OF POTENTIAL RESOURCES SUCH AS COLLEGES,
24 UNIVERSITIES, COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES, TEACHER PREPARATION
25 INSTITUTIONS, AND PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS THAT MAY BE USED FOR
26 ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING AND MEETING TEACHER NEEDS.

1 (D) A DESCRIPTION OF A PLAN FOR PROGRAM EVALUATION AND
2 UPDATING.

3 (3) TEACHER PARTICIPATION IN A PROGRAM FUNDED UNDER THIS
4 SECTION SHALL BE VOLUNTARY.

5 (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT A PROGRESS REPORT TO THE
6 LEGISLATURE NOT LATER THAN APRIL 1 OF EACH YEAR ON ALL PROGRAMS
7 FUNDED UNDER THIS SECTION.

8 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
9 all of the following bills of the 84th Legislature are enacted
10 into law:
