24	Michigan Compiled Laws.
25	Sec. 4. As used in this act:

(a) "DOD" means the United States department of defense.

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- 1 (b) "FTE" means full-time equated.
- 2 Sec. 5. The department of military affairs is authorized to utilize a
- 3 portion of the \$80,000.00 appropriated in section 1 for disbursing officers to
- 4 provide incentive payments to National Guard recruiters as long as this
- 5 expenditure does not require a supplemental or transfer of appropriations to
- 6 this account.
- 7 Sec. 6. The amounts appropriated for utilities and that portion of
- 8 contractual services, supplies, and materials used to pay for utility service
- 9 to state facilities in Section 1 may be expended in a manner consistent with
- 10 the provisions of Section 253 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, as
- Il amended by Act No. 122 of the Public Acts of 1987.
