

# HOUSE BILL No. 5544

April 13, 1988, Introduced by Reps. Stabenow and Jondahl and referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Energy.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 26 of the Public Acts of 1987, entitled  
"Michigan superconducting super collider act,"  
being section 3.814 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 26 of the Public Acts of  
2 1987, being section 3.814 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4       Sec. 4. (1) The Michigan superconducting super collider  
5 commission is created in the department of commerce.

6       (2) The commission shall consist of the following members:

7       (a) The director of commerce or his or her designee.

8       (b) The director of the department of natural resources or  
9 his or her designee.

1 (c) The director of the department of management and budget  
2 or his or her designee.

3 (d) The director of the state transportation department or  
4 his or her designee.

5 (e) The director of the state labor department or his or her  
6 designee.

7 (f) The chairperson of the department of physics at the uni-  
8 versity of Michigan or his or her designee.

9 (g) The chairperson of the department of physics and astron-  
10 omy at Michigan state university or his or her designee.

11 (h) The chairperson of the department of physics at Wayne  
12 state university or his or her designee.

13 (i) One individual, appointed by the governor, selected from  
14 a list of individuals provided by the senate majority leader.

15 (j) One individual, appointed by the governor, selected from  
16 a list of individuals provided by the speaker of the house of  
17 representatives.

18 (k) ~~Ten~~ ELEVEN members appointed by the governor, with the  
19 advice and consent of the senate, as follows:

20 (i) Two individuals from major utility companies.

21 (ii) Two individuals from labor organizations.

22 (iii) Two individuals from business or industry.

23 (iv) Two individuals from environmental organizations.

24 (v) One local government official.

25 (vi) One individual who does not hold a position in state or  
26 local government.

1       (vii) ONE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE AREA OF THE  
2 PROPOSED SITE OF THE SUPERCONDUCTING SUPER COLLIDER.

3       (3) A vacancy on the commission shall be filled in the same  
4 manner as the original appointment.

5       (4) Within 10 days after all appointments have been made  
6 under this section, the commission shall hold its first meeting.

7       (5) At the meeting required in subsection (4), the commis-  
8 sion shall elect a chairperson and other officers as it considers  
9 necessary from among its members.

10       (6) Following the meeting required by subsection (4), the  
11 commission shall hold meetings as considered necessary by the  
12 chairperson.

13       (7) A majority of the members of the commission shall con-  
14 stitute a quorum for the transaction of business at a meeting of  
15 the commission. Action by the commission shall be by a majority  
16 of the votes cast.

17       (8) The members of the commission shall receive per diem  
18 compensation as determined by the legislature and shall be  
19 allowed actual and necessary expenses incurred in performance of  
20 their official duties.
