

# HOUSE BILL No. 5667

May 25, 1988, Introduced by Reps. Ciaramitaro, Hollister, Brown, Johnson, Ostling, Emerson, Harrison, Joe Young, Sr. and DeMars and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 111h of Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended  
"The social welfare act,"  
as added by Act No. 227 of the Public Acts of 1986, being section 400.111h of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 111h of Act No. 280 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1939, as added by Act No. 227 of the Public Acts of 1986,  
3 being section 400.111h of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended  
4 to read as follows:

5       Sec. 111h. (1) ~~Sections~~ EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN  
6 SUBSECTION (2), SECTIONS 111a to 111g shall not apply to a pro-  
7 vider of medical services under this act if that provider is  
8 required by federal or state law, regulation, or directive to

1 accept ~~medicaid~~ recipients OF THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM  
2 ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS ACT.

3 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (1), THE DIRECTOR MAY TAKE  
4 ACTION UNDER SECTION 111D(1)(A), (B), (C), (D), OR (F) IF 1 OR  
5 MORE OF THE FOLLOWING OCCUR:

6 (A) A PROVIDER CONTINUES TO SUBMIT DUPLICATE CLAIMS FOR  
7 SERVICES, SUPPLIES, OR EQUIPMENT FOR WHICH THE PROVIDER HAS  
8 ALREADY RECEIVED REIMBURSEMENT FROM ANY SOURCE AFTER RECEIVING  
9 NOTICE FROM THE DEPARTMENT TO STOP SUBMITTING DUPLICATE CLAIMS.

10 (B) A PROVIDER RECEIVES REIMBURSEMENT FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE  
11 AFTER RECEIVING MEDICAID PAYMENT AND DOES NOT REFUND THE APPRO-  
12 PRIATE PORTION OF THE MEDICAID PAYMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT.
