

# HOUSE BILL No. 5681

May 26, 1988, Introduced by Reps. DeBeaussaert and Hertel and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend section 18 of article V of Act No. 254 of the Public Acts of 1933, entitled as amended "The motor carrier act," being section 479.18 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 18 of article V of Act No. 254 of the  
2 Public Acts of 1933, being section 479.18 of the Michigan  
3 Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

### 4 ARTICLE V

5 Sec. 18. (1) ~~Revocation, rehearings.~~ The commission may,  
6 upon application of any person or any motor carrier, or upon its  
7 own motion, and upon at least 10 days' notice to the parties  
8 affected thereby, for good cause, and after an opportunity to be  
9 heard, revoke, suspend, alter, amend, or modify any ~~and all~~ of  
10 its findings or orders. ~~; but no~~ HOWEVER, A certificate or

1 permit shall ONLY be amended, altered, modified, revoked,  
2 suspended, or impaired ~~, except only~~ after like notice and  
3 opportunity to be heard and upon clear proof of good, just, and  
4 sufficient cause. ~~It shall have full power and authority to~~ IN  
5 ADDITION, A PERSON OR MOTOR CARRIER MAY ALSO BE SUBJECT TO A  
6 CIVIL FINE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00 FOR EACH VIOLATION OF THIS  
7 ACT, A RULE PROMULGATED OR AN ORDER ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS ACT,  
8 OR A TERM OR CONDITION OF A CERTIFICATE OR PERMIT. EACH DAY THE  
9 VIOLATION CONTINUES SHALL CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE VIOLATION.

10 (2) THE COMMISSION MAY grant rehearings in all proceedings  
11 before it upon petition filed within the time allowed by law to  
12 bring proceedings for review. All orders entered ~~in accordance~~  
13 ~~with the provisions of~~ PURSUANT TO this section shall be served  
14 and take effect as ~~herein~~ provided IN THIS ACT for original  
15 orders, and the time allowed by law to bring proceedings to  
16 review any order of the commission shall continue after the order  
17 denying the hearing or after the order made upon a rehearing.  
18 The commission shall keep a docket of all causes and proceedings  
19 under this act and upon request, upon payment of a reasonable  
20 fee, ~~therefor,~~ shall furnish any interested party fair copies  
21 of any application, answer, petition, motion, order, finding,  
22 certificate, or permit on file with, or made or issued by it in  
23 any proceeding.
