- 1 in letters of not less than 3 inches in height. This information
- 2 shall be conspicuously placed upon the vehicle.
- (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), ALL MOTOR TRUCKS, 3
- 4 TRACTORS, TRAILERS, OR SEMITRAILERS WEIGHING MORE THAN 3,500
- 5 POUNDS IN OPERATION UPON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS OF THIS STATE SHALL
