A bill to amend sections 730 and 731 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, entitled

"Michigan election law,"

being sections 168.730 and 168.731 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 730 and 731 of Act No. 116 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1954, being sections 168.730 and 168.731 of the
- 3 Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 730. At every election, A CANDIDATE, each of the
- 5 political -parties PARTY, and -any AN incorporated organization
- 6 or organized committee of citizens interested in the adoption or
- 7 defeat of any measure to be voted -for or upon at -such THAT
- 8 election or interested in preserving the purity of elections
- 9 and in guarding against the abuse of the elective franchise

- 1 may designate challengers as -herein provided IN THIS ACT.
- 2 Challengers shall be registered and qualified electors of the
- 3 city or township in which they serve. A candidate for nomination
