- 4 (d) Three members appointed to the council by the governor 5 from a list of 6 active law enforcement officials submitted by 6 the Michigan sheriffs association.
- 7 (e) One member appointed to the council by the governor from 8 a list of 3 names submitted by the fraternal order of the 9 police.
- (f) One member appointed to the council by the governor from
  11 a list of 3 names submitted by the metropolitan club.
- (g) One member appointed to the council by the governor from
  13 a list of 3 names submitted by the Detroit police officers
  14 associations.
- 15 (H) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED TO THE COUNCIL BY THE GOVERNOR FROM
