

# SENATE BILL No. 440

September 23, 1987, Introduced by Senator ARTHURHULTZ and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to repeal Act No. 289 of the Public Acts of 1964,  
entitled

"An act to provide for the study and development of plans for the reorganization of school districts and for elections to accomplish same; to provide for the creation of state and intermediate reorganization committees; to prescribe their powers and duties; to provide for hearings and elections on reorganization plans; and to prescribe the powers and duties of the superintendent of public instruction,"

being sections 388.681 to 388.693 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Act No. 289 of the Public Acts of 1964, being  
2 sections 388.681 to 388.693 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 repealed.
