

# SENATE BILL No. 526

October 28, 1987, Introduced by Senator WELBORN and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice, Urban Affairs, and Economic Development.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 302 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled

"An act to define and prescribe the penalties for the crime of rioting and related crimes; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

being section 752.544 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 2a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 302 of the Public Acts of  
2 1968, being section 752.544 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended and section 2a is added to read as follows:

4       SEC. 2A. A PERSON SHALL NOT WILLFULLY INSTIGATE, CAUSE,  
5 ATTEMPT TO CAUSE, ASSIST IN CAUSING, OR CONSPIRE TO CAUSE A RIOT  
6 AT A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "RIOT  
7 AT A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY" MEANS 3 OR MORE PERSONS, ACTING  
8 IN CONCERT, WHO INTENTIONALLY OR RECKLESSLY ENGAGE IN VIOLENT

1 CONDUCT WITHIN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY THAT THREATENS THE  
2 SECURITY OF THE STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY OR THREATENS THE  
3 SAFETY OR AUTHORITY OF PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING THE  
4 SECURITY OF THE STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

5       Sec. 4. (1) A violation of ~~sections 1 or 2~~ SECTION 1, 2,  
6 OR 2A is a felony, punishable by not more than 10 years in prison  
7 or a fine of not more than \$10,000.00, or both.

8       (2) A violation of section 3 is a felony, punishable by not  
9 more than 5 years in prison or a fine of not more than \$5,000.00,  
10 or both.
