THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 4 SEC. 2A. A PERSON SHALL NOT WILLFULLY INSTIGATE, CAUSE,
- 5 ATTEMPT TO CAUSE, ASSIST IN CAUSING, OR CONSPIRE TO CAUSE A RIOT
- 6 AT A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "RIOT
- 7 AT A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY" MEANS 3 OR MORE PERSONS, ACTING
- 8 IN CONCERT, WHO INTENTIONALLY OR RECKLESSLY ENGAGE IN VIOLENT

- 1 CONDUCT WITHIN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY THAT THREATENS THE
