## **SENATE BILL No. 845**

May 5, 1988, Introduced by Senators FESSLER and O'BRIEN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to provide immunity from civil liability to certain institutions of higher education and health facilities and employees of institutions of higher education and health facilities.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Health facility or agency" means that term as defined
- 3 in article 17 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of the
- 4 Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.20101 to 333.22181 of the
- 5 Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 6 (b) "Institution of higher education" means a college or
- 7 university described in section 4, 5, or 6 of article VIII of the
- 8 state constitution of 1963 or a junior college or community
- 9 college established pursuant to section 7 of article VIII of the
- 10 state constitution of 1963.

- 1 Sec. 2. An institution of higher education or a health
- 2 facility or agency, or an employee of an institution of higher
- 3 education or health facility or agency that participates in good
- 4 faith in a training or educational program approved by the
- 5 Michigan fire fighters training council shall not be liable for
- 6 civil damages as a result of any primary or continuing training
- 7 or educational practices by a person who participated in such
- 8 program unless the institution of higher education, health facil-
- 9 ity or agency, or employee was grossly negligent or committed
- 10 willful and wanton misconduct.
