

SENATE BILL No. 1003

September 22, 1988, Introduced by Senators KELLY, WELBORN, and SCHWARZ
and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to amend section 328 of Act No. 150 of the Public
Acts of 1967, entitled
"Michigan military act,"
being section 32.728 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal
certain parts of the act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 328 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of
2 1967, being section 32.728 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 328. (1) The adjutant general shall request civilian
5 positions and personnel of the military establishment, as he
6 ~~deems~~ OR SHE CONSIDERS necessary, to be included in the classi-
7 fied state civil service. He ~~shall~~ OR SHE also ~~have~~ HAS the
8 authority to call officers and enlisted personnel, as he OR SHE
9 may designate, to special duty in the military department.

1 Officers and enlisted personnel called to special duty shall
2 receive pay and allowances equal to that of active army or air
3 force personnel of like grade and service.

4 (2) When special duty personnel ~~other than general grade~~
5 ~~officers~~ receive military pay from the federal government for
6 services performed during the hours of an actual workday, as des-
7 ignated by the adjutant general under section 114, they shall be
8 charged with a day of leave or a day of leave without pay.

9 Section 2. Section 305 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of
10 1967, being section 32.705 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
11 repealed.
