A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4038 AS INTRODUCED 2-1-89

The bill would amend Public Act 372 of 1927 to make specific provision for renewal of permits to carry pistols. (Under the law, a handgun license is issued for a definite period of up to three years.) The bill would in general extend existing procedures to renewals; however, the bill would excuse an applicant for renewal from having fingerprints taken if he or she had been fingerprinted previously under the act, had those fingerprints on file with the state police, had not been convicted of a misdemeanor within the preceding three years, and made reference to the fingerprints on file in accordance with state police rules.
