A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4069 AS INTRODUCED 2-2-89

Public Act 109 of 1987 amended the Michigan Vehicle Code to explicitly authorize courts to order the installation of an ignition interlock device as a condition of probation for someone convicted of drunk driving. (Such devices prevent a car from starting unless someone first passes a breathalyzer test on an attached breath analyzer.) The bill would amend the code to require any ignition interlock order to be noted on the abstract of conviction that the court sends to the secretary of state, and to require that this information be entered into the secretary of state's computer system.
