A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4073 AS INTRODUCED 2-2-89

The bill would amend the School Code to specify that those who teach pupils in elementary and secondary public schools about acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) would be required to have special training in AIDS education for young people. The state education board, in cooperation with the Department of Public Health, would be responsible to train those who trained teachers to teach AIDS education as required in the bill, and would have to provide for the development and distribution to school districts of material pertaining to the teaching of AIDS to young people.
