A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4082 AS INTRODUCED 2-7-89

The federal Low-Level Radioactive Waste Policy Act provides for the development of low-level radioactive waste compacts among states as a tool for managing low-level radioactive waste to encourage regional management of the waste. Michigan is a member of the Midwest Interstate Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact. The bill would repeal the section of law that enters Michigan into the Midwest compact.
